QUICK SUMMARY:

This wine was made exclusively from grapes contained in the first row of vines from the original Charles Coury Vineyard planted in 1966. These same vines were used to collect cuttings for the establishment of the Coury Nursery. Found in this row are some of his most prized grapes; Sylvaner, Gouges Blanc, Melon de Bourgogne, Flora, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Riesling. These grapes were harvested together then whole cluster pressed on the same day. The resulting juice was co-fermented using only native yeasts and aged for 20 months in neutral French oak barrels. This was bottled unfined (vegan) and unfiltered. Our label is an original image of Chuck and Gypsy walking up his first row of vines. Truth will out.
