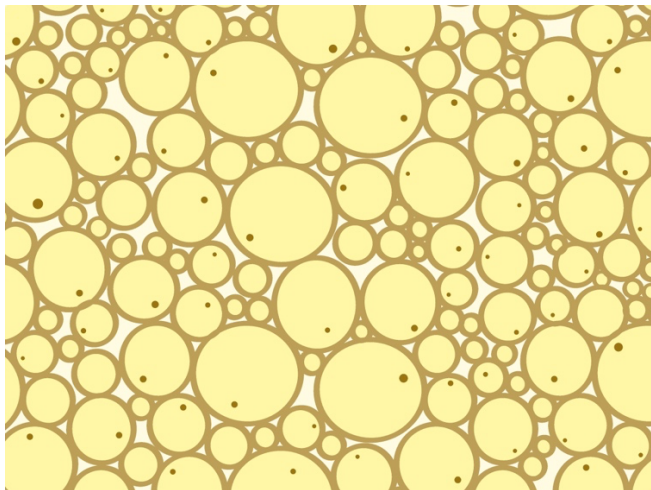
## 'MILLERANDAGE'

### CHARDONNAY (CLONE 548)

**Redacted Vineyard, Tualatin Hills AVA  
Willamette Valley, Oregon, U.S.A**

#### QUICK SUMMARY:

Our vineyard is found on a simple hill that has been at the heart of the Willamette Valley wine story since the late 1880's. Known as "Wine Hill" by the locals, this hill behind Forest Grove is hallowed ground. Our "Millerandage" line up of wines is an extension of that same history. Grown just off Highway 8 in deep loess soils, we specialize in the often maligned and misunderstood Chardonnay clone 548. This clone produces very small clustered grapes and can suffer from "hens and chicks" (aka millerandage). For us, this is an advantage, as the wines have high skin-to-juice ratios, resulting in an incredible tannic structure and high levels of natural acidity. The wine was fermented and aged in neutral French oak barrels for 11 months, then bottled unfiltered (vegan) and unfiltered.
